The cockade was a symbol of the Jacobite cause, and was based on the white rose emblem of the Stuart dynasty.
Gentlemen would wear the cockade on their bonnets, and ladies might wear one in their hair or attached to their dresses.
 You will need: 13 strips of white paper. We made it with strips 2 cm x 10¹/₂ cm (half the width of a piece of A4 paper). 1 square of cardboard approx 3cm square. Glue stick
